
















## Texture of the Surface of a Seed, Fruit or Other Disseminule Type

This character refers to small-scale surface patterns. High magnification may be necessary in some cases to discern a pattern. More than one pattern may exist on a disseminule's surface.

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>hairy</b></p>  <p>hairs may be short or long, sparse or thick</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>scabrous</b></p>  <p>covered with small projections that are rough to the touch</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>glandular</b></p>  <p>having glands, which are secretory structures</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>tuberculate/papillate</b></p>  <p>covered with warty, nipple-like, or otherwise shaped projections</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>honeycombed</b></p>  <p>a netted pattern of distinctly raised walls surrounding depressed interspaces (alveolate)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>cobblestone-like</b></p>  <p>the netted pattern of walls is at a lower elevation than the raised interspaces</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>reticulate</b></p>  <p>the netted pattern of walls (reticulum) and interspaces are at ± the same elevation</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>wrinkled</b></p>  <p>irregularly furrowed, ridged or creased</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ridged</b></p>  <p>a regular pattern of parallel (sometimes concentric) ridges and grooves</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>granular</b></p>  <p>a grainy surface</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>striate</b></p>  <p>having fine parallel lines, including those made by shallow grooves and low ridges</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>pitted</b></p>  <p>surface with small depressions where the areas between the hollows do not take on the form of a distinct reticular net</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>bubbled</b></p>  <p>covered with bubbles (colliculate, blistered)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>no distinct texture</b></p>  <p>smooth (top) or irregularly textured (bottom)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>spiny</b></p>  <p>having slender, stiff, sharp projections oriented in the general plane of the structure (echinate, muricate)</p>
